

COMBINED PLANT AND ANIMAL CULTIVATION



The combined cultivation of plants and animals in the fields brings many benefits. The biggest is that when animals graze the plants, they begin to fight for recovery and put more carbon into the soil, thus feeding the microorganisms, from which in return they receive nutrients.

The place of animals is grazing in the field. They apply directly to the field rich in bacteria and minerals, saliva, urine and excrement, i.e. more carbon, bacteria and nutrients. Integration with different species of animals speeds up the process of soil recovery many times over. Integration with animals reduces the need for herbicide, because the animals “mow” and trample the cover crops and weeds.
